I would like to welcome Mr McCrum back to the WKPS teaching team. Some of you will know Mr McCrum from his recent time in Class 5 whilst Mrs Burrows was absent. From September, Mr McCrum will teach full time in Class 5.

## Transition

On Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July, your child's current class teacher will share with them which class they are going into next year. We tell the children in the morning so we can provide any support/reassurance that may be needed and to give time for the children to ask any questions. The children will visit their new class teacher and classrooms for a short period of time on the 4<sup>th</sup> July. This will take place between 11:00am and 11:30am. Your child will come home with a letter on Tuesday afternoon informing you of which class they are in next year.

When organising the new classes many factors are taken into consideration e.g. friendships, attainment, pace, support and number in the year group. Please can I ask that you support our class decisions and talk positively with your child about the upcoming changes. However, if you do have any serious concerns, please do not hesitate to get in touch with me and/or your child's current class teacher.

On Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> July your child will spend a longer part of the day in their new classes. Your child should come into school as normal and will register in their current classes. At 9:15am the children will move into their new classes until 11:40am. After lunch, the children will go back into the new classes from 1:15pm until 3:00pm. The children will be dismissed at the end of the day by their normal class teacher using their normal exits. Our current Year 6 children will be visiting their new schools on this day.

Class 3 have their 4<sup>th</sup> swimming session on 6<sup>th</sup> July. Therefore, their visit to their new classes will be slightly shorter for the afternoon session.

### F1 & F2

Due to a low birth rate in the area, we do have spaces available in F1 and F2 from September. If you have any friends or family looking for a school place, we would be happy to show them around our amazing school. We now take children from their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday in F1.
