Singing

- A song has a structure - verse and chorus
- Good techniques for singing are:
- Posture - with more space in your chest your lungs can create longer notes.
- Breathing - this improves sound volume.
- Warm ups - so you don't hurt your voice.

Composing

- A soundscape is made up of all the different sounds that help to create a sense of atmosphere.
- It is worth considering the timbre (sound) of the instrument and the volume (dynamics) to create a soundscape.
- Use features such as legato (smooth) and staccato (detached) to create sounds.

Performing

- Working together and rehearsing improves a performance.

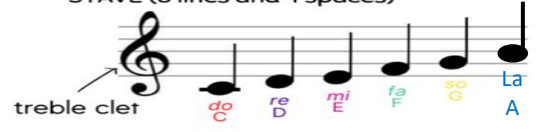

4. Percussion
