Dear Parents/Carers

As part of their history curriculum the children in Year 5 and Year 6 will be visiting Styal Mill to gain first-hand experience of home, school life and working conditions in Victorian times. **Once again it is hoped that staff, children and helpers will come in Victorian dress.**

We will be leaving school promptly at 9.00am and returning around 3.30pm on Friday 3rd November 2017.

The children will require a drink (no glass bottles or cans please) and a packed lunch (in a named carrier bag that can be thrown away afterwards). They also need to bring another bottle of water to drink during the day.

In order for this trip to Styal Mill to take place we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £15.00 (£7.50 if your child is eligible for Pupil Premium*). This covers the cost of entry to the Mill and Apprentice House, a tour guide, insurance and coach travel. Should you have any problems with the voluntary contribution please contact me as we would like all children to have this experience.

So that we adhere to the correct adult and child ratios we will need parent volunteers to assist us on this trip. If you are available to join us on Friday 3rd November please indicate on the slip below. As we are restricted with the number of additional adults that we can take with us we will let you know as soon as we can if you are able to join us. Please bear with us whilst we collect all of the slips in from the children and see how many parents we need for each class. We will confirm with all parents that indicate on the slip below whether we require your help or not.
