## **Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5 Swimming**

We have the opportunity for Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5 to attend additional swimming sessions during this half-term. The children will go in year groups on the following dates:

14<sup>th</sup> June - Year 3

21<sup>st</sup> June – Year 5

28<sup>th</sup> June - Year 4

5<sup>th</sup> July – Year 3

12<sup>th</sup> July – Year 5

19<sup>th</sup> July – Year 4

We apologise that each year group are not swimming on consecutive weeks, but this is due to accommodating other events in school that we do not wish children to miss out on.

Each year group will be split into two groups. Nearer the time class teachers will inform the children as to which group they are in.

Group 1: to leave school at 9.00am and aim to leave the Concourse at 10.00am

Group 2: to leave school at 9.20am and aim to leave the Concourse at 10.30am

So that we adhere to the correct ratios your support walking the children to and from the Concourse would be very much appreciated. We welcome as many people as possible each week walking with us.

The kit they will need is as follows:

**Boys:** towel, swimming trunks (not baggy shorts)

**Girls:** towel, full swimming costume (no tankinis or bikinis)

Please provide a bag for your child to carry their kit in and to keep their clothes in when at the Concourse.

Your child may also wear swimming goggles if they wish but please ensure that they do not bring either shampoo or spray deodorants with them.

**We also request that your child does not wear earrings to school on the day. They will be asked to remove them and be responsible for keeping them safe. The Concourse has asked that plasters not be worn as they can come off in the water.**
