Uniform & PE Days

Please can I request that we adhere to the correct school uniform at all times. This includes no nail varnish, hair tied back if longer than shoulder length and only stud earrings, which need to be removed for PE days, prior to coming into school.

Year Group	PE Kits
EYFS – F1 and F2	Need to come to school in PE kits every Monday . Starting on Monday 11th September
LKS2 – Year 3 and Year 4	Need to come to school in PE kits every Wednesday . Starting on Wednesday 6 th September
UKS2 – Year 5 and Year 6	Need to come to school in PE kits every Thursday . Starting on Thursday 7th September
KS1 – Year 1 and Year 2	Need to come to school in PE its every Friday . Starting on Friday 8 th September

The class teachers will communicate with you if there is a second day that PE kits are needed. This will also be shared at the Meet the Teacher meetings next week.

Every day counts in school and good attendance (97% or more) is vital for children to make good progress in all areas of school life. Please can you check the term dates to ensure that no holidays or time off is needed in school time. However, I appreciate that there are exceptions and, in these cases, please talk to the School Office about the procedure to follow.

Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC)

I am sure that many of you will have seen headlines on the news and on social media about RAAC. RAAC is a lightweight form of concrete which was used in schools, colleges and other building construction from the 1950s until the mid1990s. Earlier this year Wirral Local Authority contacted all Wirral Schools about RAAC. We were contacted, and at that point, Wirral Local Authority did not identify us as a school of concern. We have continued to comply with the DfE requests and our school was fully surveyed in June 2023; the outcome of this survey is expected within 3-5 months of the inspection. We will keep you up to date and comply with any further DfE expectations.

We look forward to seeing you back in school in the morning. School gates open at 8:30am and the whistle will go at 8:40am.
