

Dear Parents,

We would like to offer the opportunity for both boys and girls in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 to participate in a fun and enriching weekly Football Club after school, which will be organised and run by Football First Academy. Graham Branch will be the football coach who will be running the weekly sessions.

The football club will take place every Thursday after school for 1 hour, 3:30pm - 4:30pm. The club will run for 5 weeks and will cost £17.50 (or £8.75 for pupils eligible for Pupil Premium*). Please make all cheques payable to **Graham Branch**.

If for whatever reason your child can not attend one of the sessions it is vital for Safeguarding reasons that the school office is made aware as soon as possible so that we know where your child is at the end of the school day, if they have not turned up to Football Club.

For each session your child will need suitable warm/waterproof clothing as the football sessions will take place outside, suitable footwear (football trainers rather than football boots as these may be slippery on the playground) and a water bottle to ensure that your child keeps hydrated.
