We are very proud of our Y5 pupils who took part in a local Community Drama production involving various local schools and other groups (including West Kirby Transition Town and a group of EAL students from Liverpool) in the park last Saturday. The event was very well planned and organised by LIPA (Liverpool Institute of Performing Arts) second year students.

The theme of the day was that our hope for the future comes from being kind to one another and to the environment - a great theme for us all – and one that links closely to our school curriculum core themes too. Each group performed a different piece of drama linked by this theme - and by the music of Bob Dylan. At the end, our children planted seeds to encourage the bees before all of the groups came together for a picnic and a Ceilidh.

Keeping children safe

This term, KS2 pupils are learning about managing worries and coping with changes. Children in Y5 and Y6 are also completing a unit of work considering different types of bullying and what children can do to address it and prevent it.

No-smoking Policy: A reminder that the No Smoking policy also applies to vaping. Please refrain in all areas of the school premises.

Eco Council have worked hard to raise awareness of food waste in school. They interviewed our Catering Manager Lou to learn more about how to reduce and reuse leftovers. The children were also asked to compose an acrostic poem to raise awareness of Waste Week.
