Democracy	 Children have many opportunities for their voices to be heard. We have a school council which meets regularly to discuss issues raised in class council meetings. Pupil voice – interviews and questionnaires to gather opinions of the children in relation to English at WKPS and outcomes acted upon where possible. Through debate and discussion we help pupils to express their views. Children to vote for their class Eco, Digital and school councillor representatives Children are encouraged to set our own targets for improvement
Rule of Law	 Follow rules in our classroom and school environment to protect the rights of all us to an education Uphold whole-school policies with regards to homework, uniform etc. The Eco-councillors created a list of rules to ensure we look after the school environment.
Individual Liberty	 We allow the children to consider and contribute to the school environment and the wider community.
Mutual Respect	 The children are expected to demonstrate respect for their environment and understand why it is important e.g. energy monitors and Eco-councillors.
Tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs	 We allow children to voice their opinions with equality for all faiths and beliefs. We approach geographical events sensitively, bearing in mind children with different faiths and beliefs.
