

British Values in RE



How are British Values promoted through RE at WKPS?

Democracy	 The children are given the opportunity to find out about a wide range of faiths and religions, allowing them to make their own decisions. During Religious Education all pupils have an equal right to be heard and democracy is modelled by the teacher. Children have an opportunity to be voice their opinions during pupil voice in relation to RE at WKPS and outcomes of interviews and questionnaires acted upon where possible.
Rule of Law	During Religious Education rules for particular faiths are thought about.
Individual Liberty	 We allow the children to express their views in a respectful manner. It is the right of the parent to withdraw their child from RE lessons.
Mutual Respect	 Children develop awareness of other cultures and are taught respect and understanding of the beliefs, opinions and traditions of a range of different religions. Children are encouraged to show respect to each other when sharing their opinions and beliefs.
Tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs	 Within class faiths are respected, recognised and shared. We celebrate a wide range of faiths, beliefs and religions as a whole school through assemblies and Religious festivals.
