Holy week	The week of events before Easter Sunday, starting on Palm Sunday.	 Church A place to pray, sing and celebrate. Often built in the shape of a cross.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Before Jesus began his teaching, he spent 40 days and 40 nights in the desert, to be with God. During this time, he had no food. Whilst Jesus was in the desert, the Devil appeared, trying to tempt Jesus. However Jesus did not give in to the devil's temptations. • During Lent Christians are supposed to be quiet and thoughtful, preparing themselves for Easter to remind themselves of the sacrifices Jesus made when he was in the desert. They pray a lot, give money to charities and give up some of the things that they might otherwise do for pleasure. • Jesus had many disciples. The 12 closest disciples to him were also known as the 12 Apostles. Modern day disciples are those who follow Jesus' teachings and believe in Him. Some people dedicate their lives to God such as priests, nuns and monks. • When Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey people spread their cloaks on the floor and spread palm branches on the road in front of Jesus, shouting "Hosanna". This known as Palm Sunday. • Jesus celebrated Passover with the 12 Apostles. As he shared the bread and wine Jesus told the disciples that one of them would betray him. Many Christians share bread and wine called Communion. • The Easter story has been used in art for many years. Some famous paintings of Jesus include Davinci's The Last Supper and The Betrayal of Christ by Ugolino di Nerio. 	
Lent	The time that leads up to Easter. It lasts for 40 day (not including Sundays).			
Ash Wednesday	The first day of Lent. It is a holy day for Christians.			
Palm Sunday	The first day of Holy Week and the Sunday before Easter. A reminder of Jesus entering Jerusalem.	<u>Religious Text</u>
