Dear Parents,

Huge thanks to our PTA for organising the Christmas Fair last Friday night, and to all of the staff and parents who helped out. It was our first to be held in the evening... I am sorry that I was unable to attend the Christmas Fair or the AGM on Tuesday, but delighted to tell you that almost £2000 was raised. Some of this will be used to buy sets of new books for Guided Reading and some to purchase new Maths Numicon resources for the children to use in class. We are also planning to spend some of the money raised on cultural events for our pupils, such as theatre / music / dance - watch this space!

## Green Flag School - Switch off fortnight

Thank you to our Eco Team and Eco Councillors, who led an Assembly to remind us all to save energy wherever we can to conserve natural resources. During Switch off Fortnight, we managed to save 57 KWH of electricity. Every classroom now has a thermometer on display, so that children can keep an eye on the temperature in the room. Our radiators are controlled individually so we can turn them down to reduce our energy consumption.

Thank you to the Broadbent Family, who purchased a weather station for our school, so that children can monitor weather conditions including temperature, air pressure and wind speed outside.

**Children in Need:** Thanks to Dan Sach and the Charity Club, who organised our Children in Need day, and thank you to everyone who contributed and came to school looking spotty!. We raised £470, including £200 from the sale of wristbands, which will all go towards supporting children in need across the UK.

**Christmas Shoeboxes:** Thank you to everyone who contributed a shoebox full of gifts to be sent to children in need in Ukraine, Romania and Albania. We sent 78 shoeboxes this year.

## Keeping children safe

We have given the children a few reminders for the dark winter months: it is harder to be seen outside so be extra careful when crossing the road; fluorescent or reflective clothing helps pedestrians and cyclists to be seen; cyclists may need lights even during the day time; when it is icy be aware that pedestrians and vehicles may slip so take extra care; avoid ice - you can't tell how thick it is. Wrap up warm, go to an ice rink and wear thick gloves if you want to skate!
