





Vocabulary

Season	A time period of the year marked by weather patterns and hours of daylight.	
Spring	The weather begins to get warmer and trees and other plants grow new leaves. The weather can be rainy.	
Summer	The hottest season that has long, usually sunny, days.	
Autumn	The weather becomes cooler and leaves start falling from many types of trees.	
Winter	The coldest season, with short days. The weather can be snowy.	
Weather	The conditions in the air above the earth such as wind, rain, or temperature.	
Ice age	A period in Earth's history when the ice expanded due to a lowering of the Earth's global temperatures.	
Artist	A person who makes art such as paintings, drawings or sculptures.
