

- All referrals are sent to Duty via generic email and added to the appropriate waiting list.
- All referrals to be triaged and accepted or declined.
- If accepted the referral is moved to the SALT waiting list whilst detailed social communication assessment is carried out by SALT.
- Once SALT report is available we can progress the referral to the Community Paediatrician and end the ASD pre-diagnostic pathway.



- Section A of the dual referral form must be completed in full including child's correct name/address/DOB and signed by Parent/Carer (verbal consent can be given as long as it is stated in the signature box)
- Section C Social Communication Concerns (ASD) must be completed in full as this form now includes the old observation profile and the previous referral to SALT.
- School can send in a completed SALT report if it has been completed by outside sources (talk about town)
- Wellcomm to be completed and attached if the child is under 7.
