90% of funding to the NSPCC comes from people supporting the charity. Here is an idea of what they allocate some of their donations towards...

- £4 pays for 1 of our trained volunteer counsellors to answer a child's call for help to Childline.
- £3 pays for the Speak out Stay Safe Programme to reach 1 primary school child, empowering them to speak out if they're worried about anything
- £5 covers the cost of answering 1 call to the NSPCC Helpline.

During the current pandemic, NSPCC has seen an increase in their services being utilised. Hopefully, supporting Number Day within our school will allow us to raise funds to support them further.
