Communication

Just to keep you up to date with our communication methods:

Headteacher Letters: You will be familiar with my Headteacher Letters to keep you up to date with different aspects within our school. These usually land in your inbox every few weeks.

Reading Sways: Library Jane produces these every few weeks to keep you up to date with our latest reading news, latest books and how to further support reading at home. All of the previous editions are available on our website if you have missed any.

Marvellous Me: This is a FREE App and we are really pleased that the majority of Parents/Carers have access to this. We use this to share with you 'marvellous moments' about your child, that as Parents & Carers we all love to receive. We also use Marvellous Me to send weekly spellings out through the message facility. Parental feedback informed us that Marvellous Me was a quick and easy way for you to access spellings each week. They are also available on our website, under 'key information for parents'. If you prefer an overview of them and want access to them. Marvellous Me is also sometimes used by staff to communicate with Parents & Carers about what the children have learnt. This gives you the opportunity to talk to the children about what they have been doing in school. Our use of Marvellous Me has evolved over time and it is a good way for staff to communicate with individual Parents & Carers effectively. At times, staff may also use Marvellous Me to send home First Aid information or reminders about events that are taking place within school so that we can keep you as up to date as possible.

We aim to be mindful how many emails we send to you. However, at times we know that several can arrive in your inbox. Where we can group items or we can wait until the next Headteacher update we do. On occasions there are letters that are specific to certain year groups and there are also times when we are instructed to send out information from the DfE, Health Services or other.
