## **Educational Visit to Liverpool Museum: Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2022**

Next week, we have planned an educational visit for all of the children in Year 3 and Year 4 to Liverpool Museum. This will be an exciting way to finish our Ancient Greece topic and explore what other wonders the museum has to offer. Our apologies that we have not given as much notice as usual. We have had some challenges booking our trip and the transport.

We will be visiting the museum on **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July**. We will leave school at 09:00 and return to school by 15:20. Pupils will need to take a packed lunch. Ideally, please bring this in a backpack.

In the museum, pupils will take part in three activities: A workshop, which is designed for Year 3 and Year 4 called 'Story telling with the Ancient Greeks'; a self-led trail of the Ancient World (comparing Ancient Greece to Ancient Egypt) and an art activity.

The Year 3 and Year 4 workshop 'Storytelling with the Greeks' focuses on Charles Le Brun's 1658 painting 'Atalanta and Meleager'. If you think your child may benefit from seeing this painting beforehand so that you can discuss the style of art. Please click on [this link](#). Within the workshop, the pupils will develop their visual literacy and storytelling skills through the Greek myth represented in the painting.

We will need some parent helpers to come with us to make this trip possible, but unfortunately we don't have many spaces on the coach.
