### Flood in Foundation Stage

We arrived in school on Monday morning to find that a pipe had corroded and had burst over the weekend and that both classrooms were flooded with water. It was hoped that a thorough clean up and dry out operation would enable us to reopen in a couple of days. By Wednesday, it was apparent that the damage was more severe. All of the flooring and some of the furniture needs to be replaced and this is now underway with the help of the Local Authority. The costs will be covered by our insurance policy, but the work may take a couple of weeks. Yesterday we were able to welcome back F2 pupils in a temporary room, and today we welcomed back F1 pupils. Please bear with us with these interim arrangements. We understand how disruptive this has been for the children and for parents and carers too and apologise for the inconvenience caused. We will keep parents of F1 and F2 pupils informed as to when we will be re-opening the unit.

#### Staff changes

Miss Oxton has informed us that she is planning to move to the North - East over the summer so will not be continuing with us in the Autumn term. We will be very sorry to see her go at the end of this term but wish her well with her move.

Today we are advertising on the Wirral website for a replacement teacher and for a part time teacher to jobshare with our Deputy Headteacher, Mrs Bailey from September.

We are happy to tell you that Miss Woods will be returning to school in July following her maternity leave.

## Classes for next year

We are in the process of planning our classes for next year. We take into consideration a wide range of factors including ensuring children are all within a group of others of similar ability, the gender balance and numbers of children of different ages as well as personalities and friendships. Inevitably, some children may be disappointed with their placement, especially if they end up split from close friends. We ask parents to be prepared to help manage any disappointment and to provide reassurance and positive messages to help them to accept and adjust. All of our classes are mixed ability and some of our classes are mixed-age. We will be letting you know and the children know which class they will be in on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> July ahead of their new class

visits on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July. We are hoping to be able to introduce the children to our new teachers on this day.

### **Summer Term 2 Home Learning & Curriculum**
