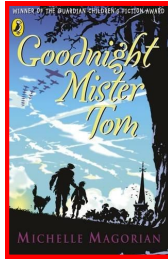

paint a watercolour of the landings

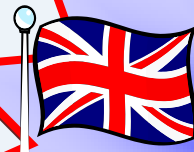
