Dear Parents,

We hope you all had an enjoyable half term week – we have all appreciated the blue skies and sunshine this week!

New gateway into EYFS

Our thanks to our Caretaker, Mr Houghton, who, over half term, has created a new gateway through to EYFS from the main playground. We hope this will go some way towards easing the congestion at the top end of the playground at the beginning and end of the school day. Parents collecting KS1 children, please stand back from the other blue gateway so the children can get through and please avoid the area in front of the bike sheds. Most of the children are very careful as they push their bikes and scooters through the playground. If you have younger children, please help them get into the same habit to avoid collisions in the playground.

Dogs

We know how lovely they are - just a reminder that they are not permitted on any school sites unless they are Guide dogs.

We also ask that you do not bring them to school or leave them at the school gate, which gets very congested by the roadside.

We have also been asked to remind all dog owners to clear up after their dogs - there has been a problem recently in the vicinity of our school. We are aware this may not be down to any parents at our school ...

Class teachers are looking forward to meeting with you next week to talk about how your child is settling into their new class and will comment on effort and behaviour. The teacher will also discuss the progress your child has made this term and to discuss the progress they expect them to make by the end of the year. For pupils in Years 1 - 6, the teachers will provide you with a brief written report to summarise this. On the back of this report are the National Curriculum objectives for English and Mathematics which provide a fairly detailed overview of what pupils of this age group should be taught. This is also a good opportunity for you to share any information you think we need to know which may impact on your child's well-being in school or to ask any questions if you have not had a chance to do this earlier in the term.
