Tuesday 14th December is our EYFS performance of Whoops-a-Daisy Angel.

With the Omicron variant in circulation and increased Covid-19 infection levels, our guidance has been continually updating over the past week. Therefore, it is vital that we all adhere to the following guidance for the two performances to go ahead tomorrow.

- Please bring your ticket with you to allow your entry.
- Entry will be through the car park gate and exit through the hall doors.
- There will be no entry into the main part of the school.
- Do not attend school or the performance if you have any Covid-19 symptoms or you are feeling unwell.
- We welcome the completion of Lateral Flow Tests before attending to check that you are negative.
- Wrap up warm as the doors/windows will be open to ensure we have good ventilation in the hall.
- Use hand sanitiser on arrival.
- Face masks must be worn at all times, including during the performance by anyone over the age of 11, unless exempt.
- Sit with people from your household and if there is space to do so, please allow distance between households.

Thank you for the support you have shown when requesting tickets for the two performances. We appreciate that this is a very special and memorable occasion and many of you would have loved to have more than two tickets. However, we have had to keep our audience numbers small.

Please can I take this opportunity to remind you that **no photos** can be taken during the performance and the performance **can't be recorded** as some of our children do not have permission for recordings/photos. We will do our best to facilitate an opportunity at the end of the performance for you to take a few family photos.

We will be opening the gates **10 minutes before each performance**, to give you time to sanitise your hands, find a seat and get settled. For the 9:20am performance, we will open at 9:10am and for the 2:15pm performance, we will open at 2:05pm.

We hope you enjoy the performance and we look forward to seeing you.
