It was the day that Jesus was crucified on the cross. Good Friday is seen as a very important day in the Christian calendar because Christians believe that Jesus sacrificed himself for others.• Many priests were jealous of Jesus and wanted to see him arrested. One of Jesus' disciples (Judas Iscariot) betrayed Jesus for 30 silver pieces. Jesus knew this at the Last Supper.• Jesus ate his final supper with his disciples. He told them at the meal that he knew one of them had already planned to betray him.• Before Jesus was arrested he said to Peter, "Truly, I tell you, this very night, before the rooster crows, you will deny me three times." Peter assured him that he would not betray him.• However, after Jesus was arrested Peter stayed at the High Priest's house for safety. He was asked by 3 different people if he knew Jesus and he denied it.
Palm Sunday	The day where Christ's enters Jerusalem. It is celebrated by processions in which branches of palms are carried.
