Home Learning questions and answers



Where can I find the tasks?

All Home Learning activities are available to view on our website for a half term at a timeyou will see a list of tasks set with useful web links. You will take home a paper copy at the beginning of each half term.



What if I can't go on the internet?

If you do not have access to the internet, our school ICT suite will be open at lunchtimes on Tuesdays and Thursdays as well as after school for your parents every Friday –and at other times on request.

What will I take home each week?

You will take home your Home Learning Diary <u>every Friday</u>. You should bring it back, signed by one of your parents or carers <u>every Thursday</u>. Home learning tasks will help you practise skills learned in school, have new experiences or find out information related to learning in school. You will also take home reading books/library books each week and can take maths games.



What do my parents/carers need to do?

Make sure you talk to your parents/carers every week about your home learning tasks. Ask your parents or carers to use the diary to tell us what you have done each week and to let us know of anything you found tricky or need more help with. Make sure they sign each week.



How will my teacher respond?

Home learning tasks will not to be marked –some, but not all tasks need to come back into school. Class teachers will respond to any comments your parents/carers make in the diary.



What if I can't fit it in?

We know your families are busy. We are setting a minimum expectation for each week to establish good study habits for you all for reading, spelling/vocabulary and maths, which you can see below. It is up to you to make time to fit them in each week. You can decide when to do tasks set for other subjects for the half term- but don't leave them all to the end!

ICT and homework club will run every Tuesday and Thursday lunchtime if you need help or extra time in school but try to complete most of your tasks at home.



What if we want to do a bit more?
