 school! The biggest dinosaur that ever lived is believed to be Argentinosaurus. It was taller than a five-storey building and heavier than a jumbo jet. The smallest fully-grown fossil dinosaur is the Lesothosaurus, which was only the size of a chicken. The dinosaur with the longest name was Micropachycephalosaurus. Its name means "tiny thick-headed lizard". Fossilised footprints have been found on Hilbre Island. 			 Key Questions?
