a) ensuring that activities are appropriately matched to children and pupils' learning needs, so they are not too easy for some or too difficult for others

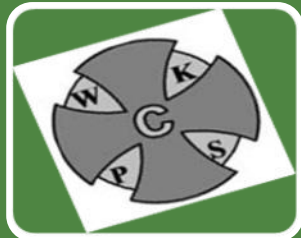
b) raising teachers' expectations of what the most able pupils can achieve

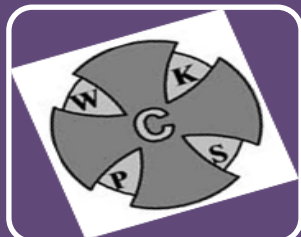
Longer term Priorities 2017-2020

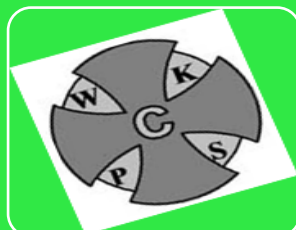

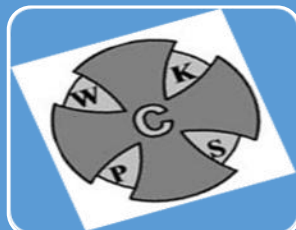
Longer term Priorities 2020-2023 following national school closure March-September 2020
