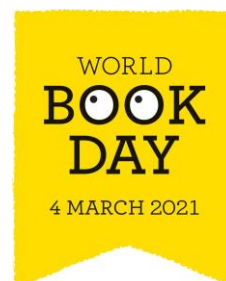

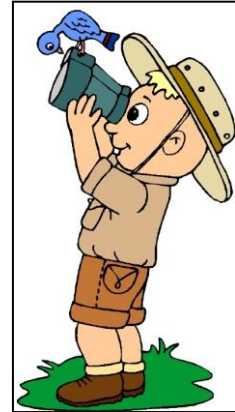
Go through the Comparing Groups Computing PowerPoint on the VLE. Can you compare and describe groups of objects?

- Count in 2s, 3s, 5s, 10s – forwards and backwards to 100...
- Double and half given numbers... e.g. double 2, double 6, half 8, half 10
- Recognise odd and even numbers.... e.g. 6 is an even number ...
