Mary Seacole



Mary Seacole was a British-Jamaican woman who overcame racial prejudice to help others. She is most famous for travelling to the Crimea in 1855 to help care for British soldiers wounded in the war.

Neil Armstrong



Neil Armstrong was born in North America in 1930. He first trained to be a pilot but then became an astronaut. He is famous for being the first man to walk on the moon.

Sir Tim Berners-Lee



Tim Berners-Lee was born in London in 1955. As a child he was fascinated by computers. He began his career as a computer software designer. In 1989, he invented a way for people to share documents and all sorts of other information on the internet. This was called the world wide web.

Crimean War	(1853-1856) A war fought between the Russians, British, French and Turkish.
inventor	A person who creates or discovers a new method or device.
famous	Known about by many people.
communication	Exchanging of information by speaking, writing, or other medium.
prejudice	An unreasonable dislike of a particular group of people or things.
voyage	A long journey involving travel by sea or in space.
continent	A very large area of land that includes all the islands with it.
mission	An expedition into space.
achievements	Something done successfully with effort, skill, or courage.
discovery	The finding or uncovering of something.
