We are having a big push in school on learning times tables! We often get asked at parents' evenings what can be done to help children at home with their maths—learning times tables is a brilliant way of helping your child and it really can make a huge difference. The expectation of the National Curriculum 2014, is that all children by Year 4 know all of their times tables up to x12.

You could help them by ...

- ✓ Counting in multiples as they walk up the stairs, ride their bike or skip- one multiples of a times table for each step, push on the pedal or skip.
- ✓ Singing the times tables.
- ✓ Playing games that allow them to use their times table knowledge.
- ✓ Mathletics also has a section that your child can use to help them with their times tables.
- ✓ Playing board games such as Monopoly and games of cards is also great, as children are thinking about adding the two numbers on the dice, working out whether the have enough money to buy the properties, giving change (if they are banker)etc...
