Dear Parents & Carers of Year 5 Children,

### **Year 6 Residential 21<sup>st</sup>- 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2023**

We are currently organising an exciting residential trip for your child when they are in year six, between Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June and Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2023. The children will stay overnight for 2 nights at the Kingswood Centre in Colomendy. During the 3 days, the children will take part in a variety of activities, including: rock climbing, kayaking, abseiling, orienteering, walking and problem solving.

The cost of the residential trip will be £200.00, which covers transport, instructor costs, meals, snacks and insurance. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium\* the cost will be £100.00. For parents with more than one child in Year 6, the cost of the trip will be £150 per child. If anyone anticipates that they may experience difficulties with payment, please come and talk to us.

The residential visit can be paid in full at any time **before 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023**, or you can pay in instalments.

Payments are through Parent Pay and we have set up a suggested schedule of instalments for you, spread across the year, should you wish not to pay for the trip in one go. We have suggested instalment dates of:

**Friday 30<sup>th</sup> September**  
**Friday 28<sup>th</sup> October**  
**Monday 25<sup>th</sup> November**

**Friday 24<sup>th</sup> February**  
**Friday 31<sup>st</sup> March**  
**Friday 28<sup>th</sup> April**

We will be holding a meeting in the autumn term to discuss the residential. We will give you the date and details of the meeting nearer the time.
