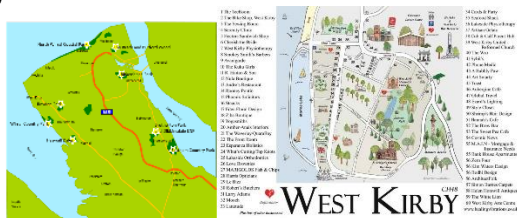


Key Facts

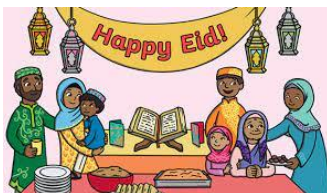
- We live in a small town called West Kirby. There are lots of lovely places to explore including the Concourse, library, park, shops and beach.

Model	A small version of something
Stick Join Attach	Connect things together
Imagination	Using our minds to create new ideas and things
Eid al-Fitr	A time when Muslims are celebrating the end of Ramadan (fasting)
