Premier Sports – Jolly Olly Sports Club Friday 18th January 2019 – Friday 29th March 2019 (3.30pm-4.30pm)

Premier Sports have worked in our school for the past few years teaching PE lessons to the children. In addition to our curriculum time PE; we are able to offer the opportunity for the children to take part in an after school Sports Club with Miss Bethany Brophy, our sports coach from Premier Sports.

This term we are offering **Jolly Olly** after school on Fridays from 3:30pm – 4:30pm for the children in **Foundation Stage Two**, **Year One and Year Two**. The 'Jolly Olly Soccer' programme is a fun, story-based format where children will practise basic ball manipulation, work on co-ordination, balance, passing, shooting, spatial awareness and goal keeping. At the same time they will be improving communication skills, teamwork, and self-confidence and adhere to rules. They will do all of this without actually realising, as they become lost in the fantasy story of 'Jolly Olly.' During the Jolly Olly story, the team Yippee FC are invited to play a football tournament on Jolly Olly Soccer Island. They will fly to the island, hire cars (footballs) from Arman (the car man) and drive to the tournament. Along the way they will carry out various tasks such as retrieving the stolen Jolly Olly Soccer Island cup and save the king.

At the end of the school day, the children will get changed in one of the Key Stage 1 classrooms. Miss Brophy will then collect the children, register them and escort them to the hall or playground. It is advisable that they do not wear their school PE kits. In the past it has been easier when the children bring in suitable clothes and trainers (more support than pumps) on the day of the club in their school bag. They can then change into these clothes at the end of the school day for the Sports Club and go home in these clothes when you collect your child at 4:30pm. The children need to be collected from the temporary visitors school entrance at the end of the Sports Club. Please provide your child with a water bottle to keep them hydrated.

The Jolly Olly Sport Club will run from Friday 18th January 2019 and finish on Friday 29th March 2019 (10 weeks). The cost for this club is £25.00 (or £12.50 for pupils eligible for Pupil Premium*).

There will be no club on Friday 22nd February as this is half term.

If your child is unable to attend any of the weeks due to other commitments, please can you let the school office know so that Miss Brophy can be informed. If your child is absent from school this information will be passed onto Miss Brophy.

If you would like your child to attend the above club please sign and return the slip below to the school office by **Wednesday 16th January.**

There are a limited number of places for this club; therefore, places will be offered on a first come first served basis.
