On the fifth day, God created birds and sea creatures. On the sixth day, God created animals to fill the earth. God also created humans to enjoy and care for all that He had made. On the seventh day, God rested.

Genesis	The first book of the Bible. Where the creation story is written.	<u>Religious Text</u>		On the seventh day, God rested. Sunday is seen by Christians as the seventh day of the week and is a day for rest and reflection - this often includes going to church.  God asked Christians to care for the world and look after it. He said "I am putting you in charge of the fish, the birds, and all the wild animals." Christians believe that they have a responsibility to look after the Earth.
