Play Live Mathematics.

Develop your confidence and understanding of the four written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

How many days are there in each month?... How many days in a year?... How many in a leap year? ... When is the next leap year?

Learn your times tables (up to 12×12) and their associated division facts.

Tell the time.... 12 hour and 24 hour clock...know when to use am and when to use pm.... Read timetables to work out when to reach a specific destination at a certain time.

List examples of.... adjectives, verbs, nouns, adverbs, prepositions, connectives, contractions and pronouns.

Camp out in the garden.

Go for an early morning walk and listen to the birds singing.
