Dear Parents & Carers,

As part of the PE National Curriculum we aim to provide opportunities for our pupils to experience outdoor and adventurous activity challenges.

We have booked for all Year 2 children to attend Barnstondale on **Monday 18th July** for a day of outdoor and adventurous challenges. We hope that it will be an exciting and memorable end to Key Stage 1 for the children. During the day, the children will work in groups to complete team building activities, and a wild wood discovery challenge, which will take place in the woods. All of the activities will be organised and run by the qualified centre staff, who work at Barnstondale. West Kirby Primary School staff will also be there to support, encourage and guide the children.

On the day, we will be leaving school at **8:30am**, so that we can arrive at Barnstondale ready to start the first challenges as close to 9:00am as possible. Please ensure that your child is at school at **8:15am at the latest**, so that we can aim to leave on time.

Year 2 Barnstondale

Lunch

All children will need to bring a refillable water bottle. School will be providing a packed lunch for free, as part of the universal school meals scheme. They will have a choice of a cheese, ham or tuna sandwich as well as a piece of fruit, biscuit and a drink. If you would prefer your child to bring their own packed lunch on the day, please indicate this on the form. The children will need to bring a rucksack to store their packed lunch in. They may also want to have an additional healthy snack in their bag, which they may get chance to eat between some of the activities.

The children need to be dressed in loose, old clothing, as the children need to be able to move around freely (no jeans). As our weather is very unpredictable, it may be a good idea if the children wear layers on the day, so that they can add or remove them according to the weather. They also need to have a waterproof coat with them, as we will be outside most of the day. They need to have suitable footwear on their feet that they can travel to and from Barnstondale in, ideally this should be trainers.

If the weather forecast is looking sunny, please apply sun cream to your child before they come to school.

We are aiming to leave Barnstondale at **2:50pm**, so that we are back at school at approximately **3:20pm**. We will keep in contact with the school office, and update them as we leave Barnstondale.

The cost of this trip, which includes the organised activities at Barnstondale and the coach is £22.00 per child, the cost has been subsided by our PE Premium budget. (£11.00 if eligible for Pupil Premium*)

Quick recap, your child will need to...













- arrive at school no later than 8:15am
- be dressed in loose, old clothes
- be wearing trainers
- bring a pair of wellies in a bag
- have a waterproof coat either on or in their rucksack
- have a sun hat in their rucksack
- have a refillable water bottle and a healthy snack in a rucksack
- have applied sun cream before coming to school
