- Dynamics enhance a song. - soft, loud, crescendos can be observed.

Notation

A chord is a group of notes played together to create a harmony.



If you are unsure where to find an Eb it might be listed as a D# on your instrument. They are the same note but known as an enharmonic equivalent.




The Orchestra

- An orchestra is a large group of instruments.
- Instruments can be divided into 4 families.

There are four families in the orchestra:

- Strings
- Brass
- Woodwind
- Percussion



They are all guided by one Conductor..

Polyrhythm	Two or more rhythms played at the same time with different pulses.
Tonality	Organising music around a central note.
Enharmonic equivalent	Two notes with the same sound written in a different way.
Motif	A repeated group of notes.
Symphony	A large scale piece of orchestral music
Natural trumpet	A trumpet without valves used between 1600-1750
Rhythm tag	Linking familiar words to rhythm to make them easier to perform.
