Numbers/ Introduction to Chinese:

- KS1 children will learn numbers to 10 in Chinese.
- China is a country in Asia. It is officially known as the People's Republic of China (PRC). It is the world's fourth largest country. China is the most populous country in the world with over 1.35 billion people living there. The capital city of China is Beijing.
- The national flag of the People's Republic of China is red with 5 golden stars. Red represents the communist revolution and the stars represent the unity of the Chinese people under their leadership.
- The currency used is the Chinese Yuan Renminbi, commonly called Yuans (CNY, ¥).
- Traditions: Chinese New Year has been celebrated for more than 4000 years. The festival lasts for 15 days. Red envelopes filled with money are given to people on New Year's Day by different members of the family
