

Underneath the Home Learning tab on our school website,

there is a link to 'Animal Awards.' This has a Maths focus and has been shared with us by another Wirral Primary school. Each level is referred to by an animal and there are different tasks and challenges that your child can complete. In September, we gave you some guidance as to which animal level your child could start on. When you or your child feels they are ready to move onto the next animal they can do so. Please note that Animal Awards is not monitored by staff as closely as Mathletics is. It is there for those children who want to complete additional Maths Home Learning. We suggest one or two of the challenges (yellow circles) each week.
