## Thursday 16th March

The children in these classes **should attend school as normal** on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March.

Children in all of the other classes should remain at home on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

Waves (before and after school provision) will continue to operate on this day and our Kitchen team will operate as usual for the children in school.
