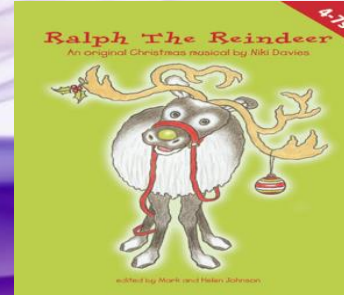


Singing

- A round is a song that repeats with voices coming in at different times.
- Standing up straight helps you to sing clearly.
- We warm up our voices to make us sing clearly.
- A chorus is the repeated part of the song.
- We count in before singing so that we start at the same time.

Vocabulary

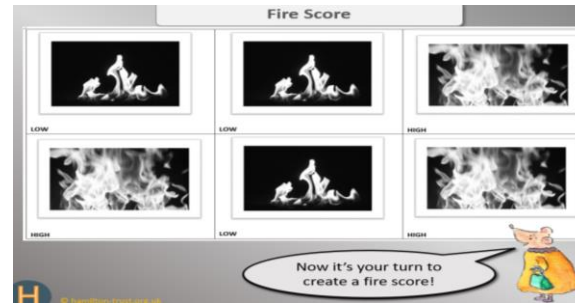
A Round. A song – sung with voices coming in at different times or together.	
Tempo Fast or slow speed	
Pulse The steady beat	
Dynamics Loud or soft volume	
Pitch High or low sounds
