Departure Arrangements

All children will need a small day bag / rucksack containing the following:

- Packed lunch in a disposable bag, a snack for when we arrive, and a water bottle (no glass) – clearly named.
- Reading book/small games e.g. card games for the coach journey.
- Warm and waterproof coat.
- Sleeping bag and pillow.

They will need to wear clothes and shoes that are warm and can get muddy as we will be taking part in a problem solving team building activity on Wednesday afternoon.

Please note we do have some food allergies (nut) in Year 6.

Safety...

- We will use a reputable coach company, with seatbelts for our transport.
- We will keep in contact with school whilst we are away and update via Twitter (X).
- We will adhere to the advised ratio for Year 6 children, and will take 4 staff members with us. (Mrs Sadler, Miss Gerrard, Mr O'Rourke and 1 tbc).
- PGL staff are on duty 24 hours a day, and as a school we will be assigned a
 group leader during our time there.
- All PGL staff are DBS checked and first aid trained, as are our own WKPS staff.
- Winmarleigh is in its own grounds so there is no need for public access.
- All the activities are on site at Winmarleigh, once we are there we will stay there.
- External doors have security codes to get in.
- Swimming ability is taken into account for any water activities.
- Risk Assessments are produced by PGL to ensure the safety of the children on all of the activities.

Kit List / Clothing

- You have been emailed a copy and this can also be found on the school website. For all outdoor activities please send old clothes/footwear that can get wet/dirty etc.
- No mobile phones / games consoles / electrical items/smart watches etc.
- No make up or perfume (this has been brought in the past!)
- £5 tuck shop money max (in change please) to spend at the tuck shop. This needs to be handed into the school office by Monday 9th October in a named envelope or wallet/purse.
- Small torch (if they want to)
- Reading book/cards etc.

The centre will provide all specialist equipment for activities e.g. harnesses, helmets etc.

Medication

- A medical form has been sent home today with your child, please complete this and bring back by Monday 11th September.
- If your child needs medication giving to them, please send this in by **Monday 9**th **October**, clearly labelled with your child's name and correct dose on to the office. This includes calpol, travel sickness tablets etc.
- If your child's medication needs change between filling in the medical form and our departure to PGL, please inform Mr Davis or Miss Henshaw so that our records can be amended in good time.

What happens if my child is unwell during the visit?

We will act on your behalf should your child need any medicine (e.g. calpol –with your consent). Each and every child will be cared for by us. If there is an emergency, you will be contacted.

Behaviour

- We expect pupils to follow our school rules whilst we are away.
- Excellent behaviour is expected at all times very important for health and safety reasons and therefore their enjoyment.
- There will be other schools there; children will be in separate areas throughout as per PGL guidelines.
- The PGL staff reserve the right to exclude a pupil from an activity if it is felt their behaviour cannot be relied upon.
- In some extreme/serious circumstances this could involve their return home.

Will I get updates during the visit?

No news is good news! We will not be contacting you during the visit, but please be assured that everybody will be having a wonderful time! We will post pictures on our school Twitter/X every evening if I can get on the WIFI. If there is an emergency, we will contact you.

My child needs medication, who will give this to them?
