Key questions

Safe and Unsafe Secrets Are secrets safe? Do all secrets need to be kept secret? Who is a safe person to talk to? Appropriate Touch Are all touches ok? If something feels wrong, what can someone do to stay safe? How can you help someone who has been asked to keep an unsafe secret? Who is a safe person to talk to? **Medicine Safety** Are medicines always helpful? What can people do to help themselves get better? Why can a medicine be harmful? How can someone stay safe with medicines?
