Eurovision Facts

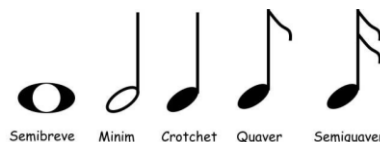
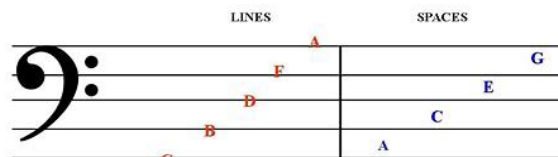
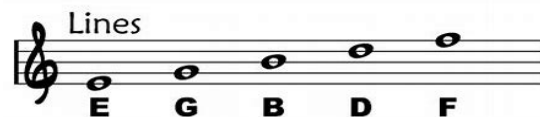
- The Eurovision song contest was first broadcast in 1956 and is one the longest-running programmes in the world.

- Abba, Bucks Fizz, Brotherhood of Man were all winners of the Eurovision Song Contest.

Performing

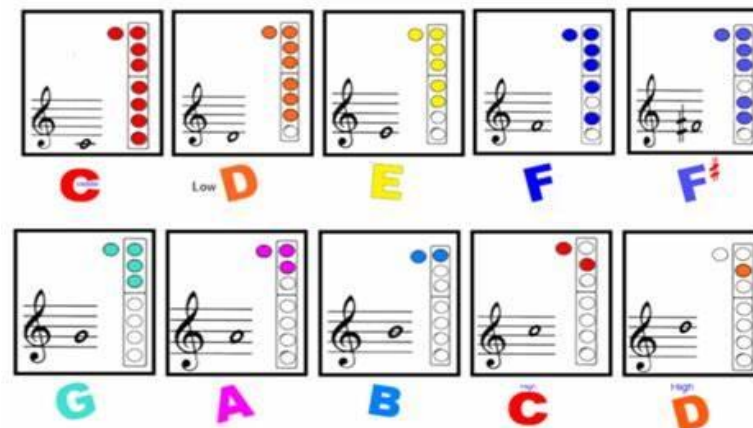
- To improve our performance we should all begin to play or sing at the same time.
