Dear Parents & Carers,

As part of our topic this half term, which is Holidays, KS1 (Year 1 and Year 2) will be going on a trip to West Kirby beach on **Wednesday 6th July** for the **morning**. Our trip will allow the children to experience a mini holiday of their own, have a hands-on experience of nature as well as developing their geographic knowledge about our local area. Whilst there, the children will be creating maps, developing observational drawing skills and building sandcastles.
