Key Facts

- The word dinosaur comes from the Greek language and means 'terrible lizard'.
- Dinosaurs laid eggs.



- Scientists think that dinosaurs lived on Earth until around 65 million years ago when they became extinct
- Around 200 years ago a 12 year old girl called Mary Anning discovered the first complete skeleton of a dinosaur that lived in the sea, on the coast of England.
- Fossilised footprints have been found on Hilbre Island.



- Some dinosaurs were herbivores which means they only ate plants and others were carnivores which means they only eat meat. Some dinosaurs ate both plants and meat and we call those ("om nom nom...") omnivores!
- In winter the trees are bare and it can be very cold. We need to wear the right clothing to keep us warm.
- It is important to have a balanced diet to help our bodies to grow and stay healthy.

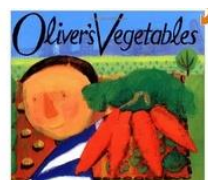

| Extinct | Animals or plants that have disappeared completely so that there are no longer any in the world. |
| Herbivore | An animal that eats plants. |
| Carnivore | An animal that eats meat. |
| Omnivore | An animal that eats plants and other animals. |
| Fossil | The marks of a plant or animal protected inside rock |
| Excavate | To uncover objects buried in the ground. |
| Winter | One of the four seasons of the year. The weather gets cold and sometimes there is ice and snow. |
| Diet | The food a person or animal eats. |
| Healthy | Feeling physically and mentally fit and well. |
