The National Curriculum requires children to take part in outdoor and adventurous activities as part of the PE curriculum. We are offering this as part of a residential experience for all of our Year 4 pupils.

This year the Year 4 residential will take place at Robinwood, Wrexham and their aim is to provide inspirational learning through adventure.

The children will stay overnight for two nights at Robinwood. During the three days they will take part in a variety of outdoors activities. The date of the Year 4 residential will be **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> April - Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> April 2022.**

The cost of the residential trip, which covers transport, insurance, accommodation, instructors, and food, is **£175.00 per child**. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium\* the cost will be £87.50. If anyone is experiencing difficulties with payment, please speak to me in confidence. We are subsidising the cost of this visit using our PE Premium Fund.

We will be operating an 'instalment payment' system to spread the cost via ParentPay.

**£35.00 (£17.50 for Pupil Premium) instalments are due:**

If you wish to pay in full or make additional payments in between these dates this is fine.

I must stress that Robinwood are strict about behaviour on their premises, so the offer of a place to each child will be dependent upon continued good behaviour in school. We will be holding a meeting in the spring term, date to follow, to discuss the residential.
