We are able to offer music lessons from September 2019 and would like to gauge the interest for us to ensure that they can be incorporated into the school timetable. This is a wonderful opportunity for children to be able to learn a musical instrument and to understand musical notation. We hope this will also enable children to develop a love of music and provide them with skills which can be incorporated into weekly music lessons and end of term performances.

Edsential Music Service offers 30 lessons during the academic year (usually 10 lessons per term) which take place during the school day or after school.

If you would like to consider your child learning an instrument from September <u>OR</u> if your child is already learning an instrument, please complete the form below and return it to the school office by Friday 5th July.

The following instruments will be available for children to learn in school:

Brass (various), Flute, Clarinet, Violin, Cello and Guitar

The cost of instrumental lessons is:

Group Lesson (20 minutes) £70 per term Individual Lesson (15 minutes) £125.00 per term

Children in receipt of Pupil Premium are entitled to half price lessons. *

Payments will be due to the school office at the start of each term. A term's notice will be required in the event of cancellation.

Edsential Music Service has instruments available to hire for children receiving music lessons (subject to availability). Your Music Service teacher can provide advice about the right instrument for your child. Charges for instruments are in addition to charges for lessons and payments are made to Edsential (not to the school).
