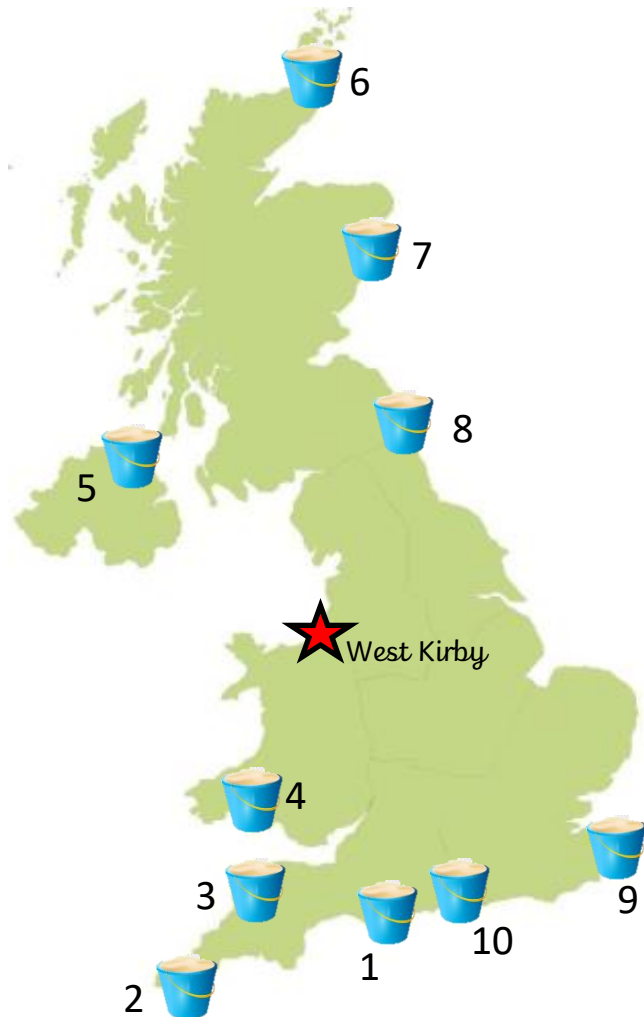


UK Famous Coastlines

We will be able to recognise the similarities and differences between West Kirby Beach and beaches around the world.

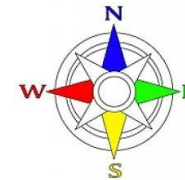


We will learn about the British Seas. We will be able to name them and locate them on a map. We will also learn about the 5 oceans of the world and be able to locate them.

Vocabulary Dozen

Coast	The part of the land next to the sea. It may also be called the seashore.
Cliff	A steep rock face close to the edge of the sea
Harbour	A place on the coast where boats and shelter safely from high winds and rough waves
Tide	The rise and fall of the ocean water level which occurs at different times throughout the year
Dunes	Hills or mounds of sand formed by the wind and held together by plants, often close to the sea
Pier	A platform on pillars stretching from the shore into the sea that people can walk on
Bay	A place where the coast bends inwards and the sea fills the space
Promenade	A paved, public walkway near to the sea front
Erosion	A process of gentle destruction caused by wind, water and other natural elements
Beach	An area of sand or pebbles next to the sea
Ocean	A huge body of salt water.
Lighthouse	A tower or other structure with a beacon light on the top to warn or guide ships at sea
