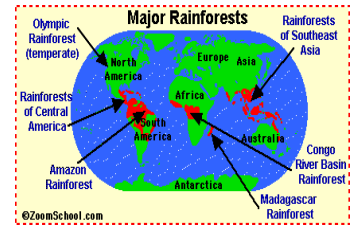

Please can we ask you to ensure that you sign your child's home school diary every week and encourage your children to independently record what they have completed each week. - Thank you.





Animal Maths Awards



Underneath the Home Learning tab on our school website, there is a link to 'Animal Awards.' This has a Maths focus and has been shared with us by another Wirral Primary school. Each level is referred to by an animal and there are different tasks and challenges that your child can complete. In

September, we gave you some guidance as to which animal level your child could start on. When you or your child feels they are ready to move onto the next animal they can do so. Please note that Animal Awards is not monitored by staff as closely as Mathletics is. It is there for those children who want to complete additional Maths Home Learning. We suggest one or two of the challenges (yellow circles) each week.

Optional extras...

- What is the climate like in a rainforest?
- Create a rainforest poster showing the layers of the rainforest.
- Find out about an animal that lives in the rainforest.
- Who lives in the rainforest? Find out about a community that lives in a rainforest, where is it in the world? How are their lives different to yours?
- Find out why the rainforest is under threat. What can be done to save the rainforests?
- Which is the world's deepest ocean? How deep is it? Where is its deepest point?
- Practise long and short multiplication and division methods
- Which continent crosses the most time zones? How many does it cross?
- Learn common equivalent fractions and practise multiplying or dividing the numerator and denominator to make other equivalent fractions.
- Visit a farm....
- Look at time zones around the world and try to work out time differences.
- Fly a kite....
- Follow a recipe and cook something for your family.
