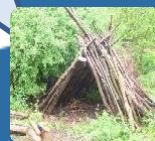


Children will learn about different areas and significant individuals of the Wirral and their role in local history.

Key stage 1

Children will learn about how Wirral was affected by WWII, the evacuation of children to countryside's and how daily life was effected.



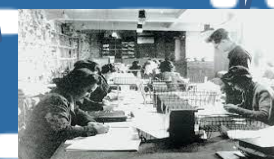
